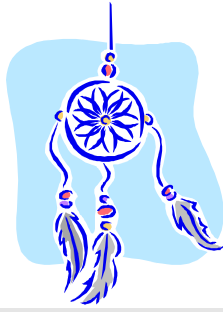
## SUMMER HOURS

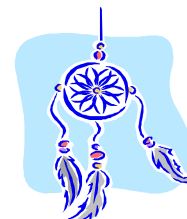
## DIRECTIONS TO THE CHAPEL

**(The Meany Center)**

*From 495, take New Hampshire Avenue north to the Hillandale Shopping Center on the right. As you exit the Beltway, move to the left lane, following the signs for the Meany Center. At Powder Mill Road, turn left and make a right into the Meany Center (past the gas station.) The Chapel will be directly in front of you as you enter. Parking is free and plentiful to your right.*

**Silver Spring MD 20903**

*From 495, take New Hampshire Avenue north. As you exit the Beltway, get in the middle lane, and you will see the Hillandale Shopping Center on the right. Powder Mill Road is the first stop light at the north end of the Hillandale Shopping Center. Turn right onto Powder Mill Road and proceed approximately 2 blocks to 1901 after you pass Green Forest Dr (you will see a big black mail box) and make a right into the driveway.*



## Update on A Place of Our Own



By the time you read this, we will have likely engaged an architectural firm to design our new sanctuary and guide us through the very complex permitting process. This process includes creating parking, planning for leveling of some of the land, removing as few trees as possible, grading the land for maximum water runoff and minimal environmental impact, etc. This effort will require at least \$50,000 from our building fund, which was significantly reduced in order to purchase 1901 Powder Mill Road.

Therefore, over the next several months, we will emphasize the Sacred Sharing Campaign to raise the necessary \$50,000. If there is an amount that you plan to share toward this effort over the next 6 months, we would welcome your pledge.

## Summer Schedule Changes

After 6 months of settling in our new spaces at the National Labor College, and at 1901 Powder Mill Road, we are ready to move forward in planning and constructing our new Sanctuary at 1901 Powder Mill Road. The universe is pushing us forward to do so in the form of some pressure to change our Use and Occupancy for the property from residential to commercial in order to accommodate larger gatherings.

As we move forward in the very complex and sensitive permit process to use the Chapel Property as a sanctuary, we have decided to avoid using the house for larger gatherings that might draw the ire of our neighbors until we can develop plans, submit them to the County and get the appropriate approvals. As a result, some activities such as the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday All Message Services and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday Salons will be held at the National Labor College immediately after services. This change will help us to maintain productive relationships with our neighbors and the County as we navigate the very delicate process of getting the appropriate permits and permissions in the most easy and effortless way.

During the summer, hospitality will be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday at the Staurbuck's in the Hillandale Shopping Center. We'll also gather informally at the cafeteria at the National Labor College after most services. Wednesday night meditation circles and the Goddess Circle will still be held at 1901 Powder Mill Road, as will the Children's Chapel.

As we move forward, and complete the permitting process, we will keep you informed, and we look forward to resuming all activities on our property at 1901 Powder Mill Road when we have acquired the appropriate permits.
